Thank you for your interest in C.E. Mission Weeks. God has touched thousands of lives through this ministry over the last twenty-five years. All of the above forms can be downloaded and filled out to hand in to you, as the group leader, by anyone who has Internet access. You are also welcome to download the forms and make your own copies to distribute to those planning to attend C.E. Mission Weeks.

There is a "Teen Letter" and "Adult Letter" for your teens, their parents, and your adults to read. This describes the C.E. Mission Weeks ministry, what they need to do to register, and how to prepare for their week of ministry.

A "Type of Work" list is provided to give you an idea of the type of work that can be done during the week of ministry.
